Trips are available to Wichita, Halstead, Hutchinson, Newton, or other places in the area. <u>At least 24-hour notice</u> is required for reservations; so make reservations as soon as possible. Cost is ... **\$20** round-trip out of county, **\$12** within Harvey County and **\$8** in Newton*. *Wheelchair clients only for Newton-to-Newton trips. <u>Call for information on reduced fares</u>.
