

**MINUTES OF**  
**BOARD OF HARVEY COUNTY COMMISSIONERS**

**April 10, 2009**

The Board of Harvey County Commissioners met in special session on April 10, 2009 to canvass the April 7, 2009 City/School General Election. Chairman Roberson called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Commissioner Krehbiel was absent.

Joyce Truskett, Harvey County Clerk, presented 24 provisional ballots for the Board to determine whether they should be counted. There were two provisional ballots for the City of Burrton where the mayoral race is separated by only one vote.

Commissioner Westfall made a motion to approve for count 12 ballots of voters who had moved within the County and not changed their address on their voter registration. According to KSA 25-2353 these ballots are valid and countable. Commissioner Roberson seconded the motion and it was passed unanimously.

Commissioner Roberson made a motion to approve for count 2 ballots of voters who had changed their name through marriage and moved and had not reregistered. According to KSA 25-2316c(a) these ballots are valid and countable. Commissioner Westfall seconded the motion and it was passed unanimously.

Commissioner Westfall made a motion to approve for count 1 ballot of a voter who had changed her name through marriage and had not reregistered. According to KSA 25-2316c(a) this ballot is valid and countable. Commissioner Roberson seconded the motion and it was passed unanimously.

Commissioner Roberson made a motion to reject 8 ballots because the voters registered after the deadline for voter registration. According to KSA 25-215 these ballots are invalid and not countable. Commissioner Westfall seconded the motion and it was passed unanimously.

Commissioner Westfall made a motion to reject 1 ballot because the voter voted at the wrong polling place and therefore voted the wrong ballot. According to KSA 25-3002 (b)(3) this ballot is partially countable. Commissioner Roberson seconded the motion and it was passed unanimously.

The approved ballots were scanned and counted. There was a write-in vote for Rusty Baker. The Commission reviewed the ballot and determined that it was clearly a vote for Rusty Baker and not Rusty Walter. The outcome of the mayoral race in Burrton was not changed as both challengers received one vote.

Commissioner Roberson adjourned the meeting at 9:32 a.m.
