Harvey Interurban operates wheelchair accessible vehicles for shopping, personal business, and recreational trips. Trips are open to **ALL** Harvey County residents. Call 284-6802 or 866-680-6802 for information. Trips depart from the 100 block of East 6<sup>th</sup> St. in Newton, (across from Newton Area Senior Center) unless otherwise noted. Reservations are “first call – first serve” and must be made at least 24 hours in advance.

**Shopping East Wichita** ♿ First Monday, go anywhere on the east side of Wichita. Plan an outing with friends. Depart 9:30 am and return around 3:30 p.m. Transportation \$8.

**Wichita Symphony, Wichita** ♿ Purchase your own ticket for the Sunday matinee performance of the Wichita Symphony. Depart 1:45 p.m. from Newton Area Senior Center and 1:55 p.m. from Kidron Bethel. Transportation \$8.

**8th... Cosmosphere, Hutchinson.** ♿ Enjoy lunch at Freddy's Frozen Custard followed by “Born to Be Wild” at the IMAX Theatre. Call 283-2222 for reservations. Depart from Newton Area Senior Center at 10:45. Transportation \$8.

**11th... Midian Shrine Circus.** ♿ Enjoy the Shrine Circus performance at the Hartman Arena. Tickets are free for the 11:00 performance and are available on a first call, first serve basis. **Personal Appointment Transportation—** Personal appointment transportation is available five days a week, Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Seats are filled on a first call - first serve basis with reservations taken up to one year in advance. Trips are available to Wichita, Halstead, Hutchinson, Newton, or other places in the area. At least 24-hour notice is required for reservations; so make reservations as soon as possible. Cost is ... **\$20** round-trip out of county, **\$12** within Harvey County and **\$8** in Newton\*.
