Notice is hereby given to the qualified electors of the City of Newton, Kansas, that a special election has been called by the City Commission of Newton, Kansas in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 41-2911(b) and will be held on the 5th day of November, 2019 for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of the City of Newton, Kansas the following question:

“SHALL THE FOLLOWING BE ADOPTED?”

“Within the city of Newton shall sale at retail of cereal malt beverage in the original package be allowed on any Sunday, except Easter, between the hours of 12 noon and 8 p.m. and shall the sale at retail of alcoholic liquor in the original package shall be allowed on any Sunday, except Easter, between the hours of 12 noon and 8 p.m. and on Memorial Day, Independence Day and Labor Day?”

Main St, Newton, weekdays 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. beginning on October 22nd, and on Saturday, November 2 from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Advance voting in-person ends at 12 noon on Monday, November 4.
