

Camp Hawk

Harvey County Camp Hawk, located 2 miles south of Newton, is a wooded 40-acre park with a 4-acre fishing pond. The primary attractions are a disc golf course and a climate controlled, cabin-style shelter that is available

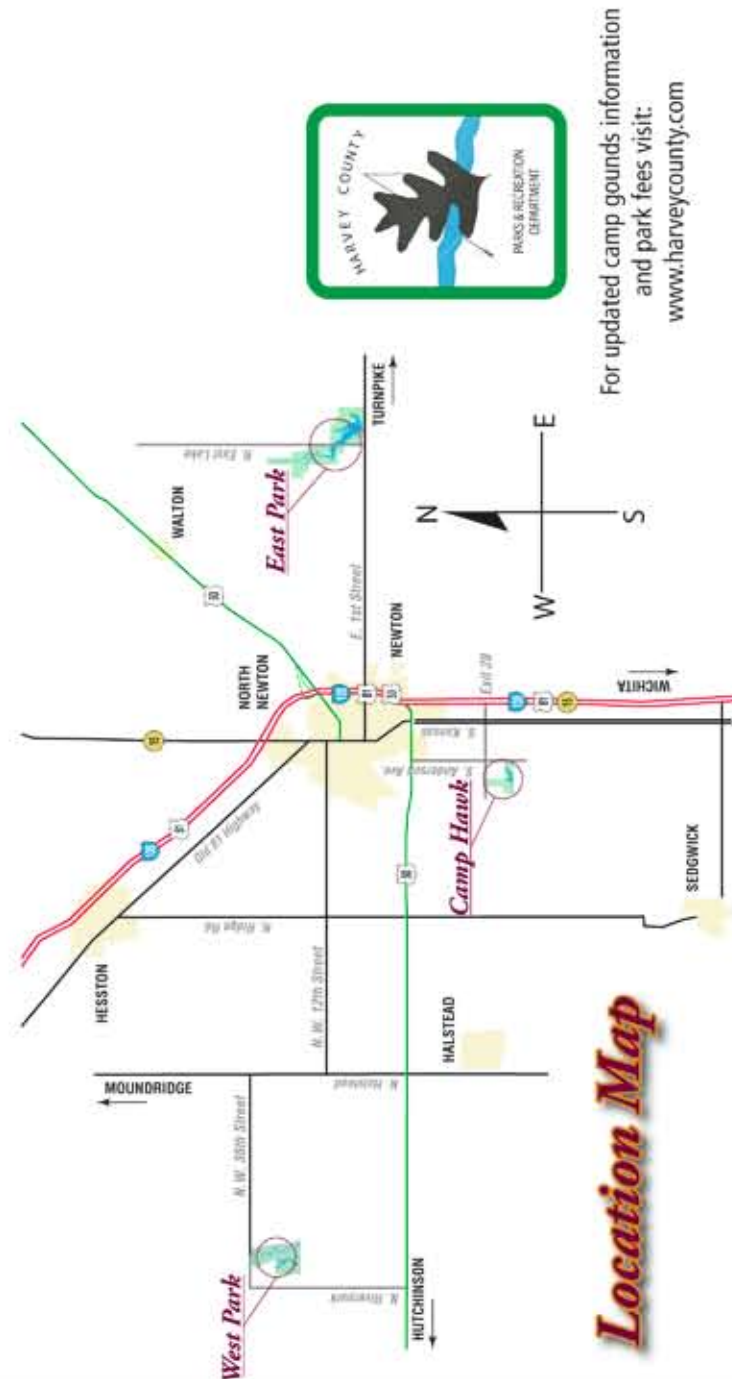
for rent year-round. The shelter holds between 100-200 people and is ideal for family reunions, company picnics, weddings, receptions and class reunions. The park also offers a playground, softball diamond, shaded picnic areas, an outdoor lighted

basketball court and primitive campsites. The pond is stocked with largemouth bass, bluegill and channel



catfish. There is no entry fee for the park; visitors are welcome to come and enjoy the disc golf course, fishing opportunities, picnic areas and playground at no charge. State fishing license requirements apply for fishing. Primitive camping is subject to a fee. Daily or annual camping permits are available at the self-service booth located near the rental shelter. ADA compliant restrooms complement the disabled patrons visit.
